

Pony Livery Charges

Full Livery: £17.50/day or £120/full week

We have a limited number of full livery spaces at The Elms.

<u>Included</u> - Daily care of pony, bedding, hay, stable, turnout as appropriate for season and pony's requirements and exercise of pony when required by the Equestrian Manager.

<u>Excluded</u> – hard feed, haylage if preferred, worming, clipping, dentist, physio, chiropractor, shoeing, routine tetanus and flu jabs (should be up to date on arrival.) All of this can be arranged by the Equestrian Manager with prior agreement with the owner and will be added to the child's bill.

Working Livery: £45 per week

<u>Included</u> – Daily care of pony, bedding, hay, stable, turnout as appropriate for season and pony requirements and exercise of pony by its owner and other children suitable for the pony in school lessons, hacks and potentially hunting. Care will always be taken to ensure that the ability of the riders is appropriate for the pony and the amount of extra work is maintained at a suitable amount for the pony's individual requirements.

<u>Excluded</u> - hard feed, haylage if preferred, worming, clipping, dentist, physio, chiropractor, shoeing, routine tetanus and flu jabs (should be up to date on arrival.) All of this can be arranged by the Equestrian Manager with prior agreement with the owner and will be added to the child's bill.

Working Livery Trial: 2 weeks £240

To qualify for working livery all ponies that are new to the Elms will need to undergo a two-week trial period to ensure they are safe for a suitable range of pupils to ride. They will need to be of a suitable age, height and temperament to be used by a wide enough range of children at The Elms to qualify for working livery. The trail period will consist of the same inclusions and exclusions as working livery with a review by the Equestrian Manager and the owner at the end of the two weeks. If the pony is suitable it will progress onto working livery.

Exeats and holidays

All ponies are expected to go home for exeats and holidays. However, ponies <u>may</u> be able to stay at school for exeats if need be, at a cost of **£50 per exeat**.

Ponies may only stay at school for holidays in <u>exceptional</u> circumstances which will need to be discussed with the Equestrian Manager prior to the holiday period.

Riding Tuition

This can be on the child's own pony, a pony on working livery or a school pony and will be with the Equestrian Team. Parents may also bring their child's pony in for a lesson if the pony does not live at school. There is no charge for ponies that just come in for the day of the lesson but any ponies staying overnight will be charged at full livery prices (£17.50 per day).

Cost per pupil per session

- Year group games lesson £12.50
- Private group lesson £17.50
- Private Individual Lesson £27.50
- NSEA training to be arranged through the Equestrian Manager

Hacking

Group hacks on the child's own pony are free as this is part of the child caring for their pony. Hacks on a pony on working livery or a school pony that does not belong to the child will be charged.

Cost per hack per pupil - £12
